<u>About alerts</u> Examples of alertable bids:- <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Transfer bids</li><li>• Unusual Notrump or Lebensohl</li><li>• Multi 2 diamond opening</li><li>• Pass or correct bids</li><li>• Weak jump responses</li><li>• Inverted minor raises</li></ul>	<u>Self- alerting bids</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Doubles and Redoubles</li><li>• All bids above 3 no trumps (except unusual high level opening, eg NAMYATS)</li><li>• Cue bid of opponents' suit</li><li>• 2 club response to an opening 1NT</li></ul> (You can ask about any alerted bid, or unalerted bid for that matter – but only at your turn to bid or play.)
