Conventions

A bridge convention is an agreement about an artificial call, or a set of artificial calls, made during the auction phase of a contract bridge game. These calls convey information about the players card holdings, so that they arrive at a suitable contract. Conventions assign more specific information to certain calls.

The most common conventions are, Blackwood, Stayman, Jacoby, Strong two clubs, cue bids, Gerber, Bergen raises. More experienced players then use other conventions such as, Lebensohl, Reverse bids, Inverted minors, Multi 2s, Splinter bids, Quantitative, Drury, Cappelletti, Michaels, and the list goes on.

So, do we keep it simple, or go for multiple unusual conventions. The most important thing is the agreement between partners, and the need to alert your opponents to an artificial bid, and to have your convention card on the table.

After reading all the unusual conventions out there, I have decided to keep it simple.
